Artists in Residence application proposals should be sent to the Galeria Aniela office with sufficient information to assess the professional standing of the applicants, their potential to benefit from the residency and ability to satisfy the selection criteria.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Because places are limited a selection process applies. Artists are offered places on the basis of proposals that address the following selection criteria:

- What benefit is expected from the residency; that is, what work would be undertaken and what might be achieved by the residency; the creation of new work inspired by the landscapes and other special merits of the Galeria Aniela Fine Art Gallery and Sculpture Park property as a 'living project' is of particular interest.
- What interaction with the local community or visitors, including students, to the properties is the artist prepared to have; examples are painting on the gallery open days, speaking with, performing to or teaching the gallery visitors, through the Artists 'Open Studio', talks and/or creating a permanent sculpture at the Galeria Aniela Sculpture Park which will be included in the permanent Galeria Aniela collection for generations to enjoy.
- How the residency would meet the objectives of the program and contribute to the development of Galeria Aniela Fine Art Gallery and Sculpture Park as well as to build on an existing collection inspired by the Galeria Aniela Fine Art Gallery and Sculpture Park property as a 'living project'.
- Artists in residence are invited to contribute to the permanent collection by donating a work of art (or some other tangible evidence of their residency) to the Galeria Aniela permanent collection, or they may wish to contribute to the development of Galeria Aniela in other ways.
- Joint Applications (couples): Such applications should be submitted with a statement outlining the purpose of the joint application. Given the competitive nature of the program and the limited accommodation and studio resources, joint applications should demonstrate the purpose and benefit of all participants coming at the same time. Also, all participants will be assessed on their individual merit and will compete equally with all other applications.
